






Do the students share a room?

The accommodation offers both single and double rooms.

Is food included?

Due to the wide range of nutritional needs among our students, meals are not included in the program. However, we offer access to an external meal service available at an additional cost.

How much money do I need per month?

Granada is one of the most important university cities in Spain, which makes the cost of food and activities very affordable.

Is transportation included?

Only the taxi service to and from Granada airport at the beginning and end of the program is included.

Parents and students must inform us in advance of the arrival time and date at Granada airport so we can arrange pick-up with our vehicle.

How do students get around the city?

To move around the city, students use public transportation, which is very efficient and costs approximately €10 per month.

Keep in mind: In Granada, people tend to walk a lot — most places are within walking distance!

Can I compete if I am under 18?

Only athletes over the age of 18 can compete officially, in accordance with FIFA regulations.
